

**REGULAR MEETING OF THE ALAMO MAYOR AND BOARD OF ALDERMEN  
(PARTICIPATION IN PERSON OR TELEPHONICALLY AT 844-474-0925, 19069431#)  
MONDAY, AUGUST 3, 2020 AT CITY HALL AT 5:00 P.M.

Mayor Emison called the meeting to order.

Roll was called with the following Aldermen present: Kenneth Bodkins(telephonically), Larry Conder (telephonically), P.B. Conley (telephonically) and John Reddick (telephonically).

Others present: Jeff Sills, Randy Camp, Ferris Arnold, Randy (in person) and Rita Reasons (telephonically).

Invocation was given by Reverend James Lavine, Lighthouse United Methodist Church.

Randy Camp advised that Governor Bill Lee's executive order allowed the meeting to be conducted telephonically and via Facebook Live, through August 2020.

Alderman Bodkins made a motion to adopt the minutes of the July 3, 2020 minutes and it was seconded by Alderman Conley. The voting is as follows: Kenneth Bodkins, Aye, Larry Conder, Aye, P.B. Conley, Aye and John Reddick, Aye. The motion carried.

Mayor Emison gave his monthly report on the following: 1) Covid-19 infected one of our personnel and 2 others were quarantined until negative test results came back. 2) Tennessee Cares Act will reimburse the town for expenses due to Covid-19. 3) The governors grant check was received at city hall today and deposited into the bank. 4) Mayor Emison stated that he wanted to acknowledge Tennessee Emergency Management for the supplies for the water/sewer plant and other city departments. 5) An offer was given to Derek Jones as a patrol man and he accepted and will be starting toward the end of the month. Bernie Robertson will be promoted to lieutenant. 6) A reminder that a special called meeting will be held in person or via telephone on August 17, 2020 T 5:00 P. M. with the following to address: video/smoke bids, zoning changes and the school budget. 7) The planning commission will meet August 13, 2020 at 5:30 P.M. to discuss annexation, zoning changes and the subdivision.

Mayor Emison introduced Ordinance 2020-4, an ordinance amending the budget for 2019/2020. Alderman Conley made a motion to adopt the ordinance on the second and final reading and it was seconded by Alderman Conder. The voting is as follows: Kenneth Bodkins, Aye, Larry Conder, Aye, P.B. Conley, Aye and John Reddick, Aye. The motion carried.

Mayor Emison showed the work done at the cemetery in Alamo by Michael Avery. Mayor Emison thanked Michael for work fixing the monuments.

Mayor Emison stated that Resolution 2020-6, a resolution for a plan of service for annexation to the east side of South Bells Street off of Woody Lane. Daniel Kitzman requested the annexation. Mayor Emison stated that the resolution would send the annexation to the planning commission. Alderman Bodkins made a motion to adopt Resolution 2020-6 and it was seconded by Alderman Reddick. The voting is as follows: Kenneth Bodkins, Aye, Larry Conder, Aye, P.B. Conley, Aye and John Reddick, Aye. The motion carried.

Mayor Emison stated that Jonathan Hart and Bobby Tucker will be mowing the rest of the year.

Mayor Emison read supplemental Ordinance 2020-5, an ordinance for errors and omissions in the municipal code that MTAS didn't correct. Mayor Emison read all the errors and omissions. Alderman Conder made a motion to adopt ordinance 2020-5 on first reading and it was seconded by Alderman Reddick. The voting is as follows: Kenneth Bodkins, Aye, Larry Conder, Aye, P.B. Conley, Aye and John Reddick, Aye. The motion carried

Mayor Emison stated that Ferris Arnold gave him a list of the potential streets/spots that needed paving. They are as follows: East Main, Nance, East Park, portion of Rebecca Lane, North Cherry, Twiddy Lane by ABB and Walnut Street. After much discussion Mayor Emison told the Aldermen to let him know if they had anymore to get bids on.

Alderman Bodkins stated that he spoke with Larry Jackson about laying the blocks in the alley next to Small Town Pharmacy. He stated that he estimated the pavement issue could be fixed for around \$600.00. Mayor Emison stated that the town would proceed with the drainage issue to get it repaired.

Alderman Bodkins stated that on Twiddy Lane the Christine Rogers property needs mowing. Alderman Reddick stated that it has been taken care of.

Alderman Reddick stated that Twiddy Lane and West Main 2 street lights were out or covered with weeds. Ferris Arnold stated he would take care of it.

Ferris Arnold stated that the dump truck was still be fixed, waiting on parts for the front end.

Alderman Bodkins thanked Ferris Arnold, Rita Reasons, all the Aldermen and the Mayor for all the hard work that they do.

With no further business to come before the board Alderman Bodkins made a motion to adjourn and it was seconded by Alderman Conley. The voting is as follows: Kenneth Bodkins, Aye, Larry Conder, Aye, P.B. Conley, Aye and John Reddick, Aye. The motion carried.
