

**SPECIAL CALLED MEETING OF THE ALAMO MAYOR AND BOARD OF ALDERMEN

Mayor Emison called the meeting to order.

Roll was called with the following Aldermen present: Kenneth Bodkins(telephonically), Larry Conder (in person), P.B. Conley (telephonically) and John Reddick (telephonically).

Others present: Joy Cooke, Brenda Reddick, Lawrence Hardin, Patrick Conley, Neal Towater, Tracy Fernley, Shannon Haynes, David McKee, Reecha Black, Randy Camp (telephonically) and Rita Reasons (telephonically).

Mayor Emison gave the invocation.

Joy Cooke presented the 2020/2021 budget for the city school. A motion was made by Alderman Conley to adopt the budget for the school and it was seconded by Alderman Bodkins. The voting is as follows: Kenneth Bodkins, Aye, Larry Conder, Aye, P. B. Conley, Aye and John Reddick, Aye.

Mayor Emison stated that he enacted a water cut off moratorium, when Covid-19 started in March. A motion was made by Alderman Bodkins to begin cut-off's beginning September 1, 2020 and be published on the water bills and it was seconded by Alderman Conder. The voting is as follows: Kenneth Bodkins, Aye, Larry Conder, Aye, P. B. Conley, Aye and John Reddick, Aye.

Mayor Emison opened the public hearing at 5:32 P.M. There were not comments either in person or telephonically.

Mayor Emison stated that Ordinance 2020-7, an ordinance of annexation to annex the Daniel Kitzman property located on South Bells Street and Woody Lane. He stated that he had sent the plat and subdivision ordinance to Ed Hargraves to get a price on overseeing the project. A motion was by Alderman Bodkins to adopt the ordinance and it was seconded by Alderman Conder. The voting is as follows: Kenneth Bodkins, Aye, Larry Conder, Aye, P. B. Conley, Aye and John Reddick, Aye.

Mayor Emison stated that Ordinance 2020-6, an ordinance changing the zoning on the Daniel Kitzman property from R-2 to R-1. Alderman Conley made a motion to adopt the ordinance and it was seconded by Alderman Bodkins. The voting is as follows: Kenneth Bodkins, Aye, Larry Conder, Aye, P. B. Conley, Aye and John Reddick, Aye.

Mayor Emison closed the public hearing on the annexation.

Mayor Emison stated that the bids were received and opened on the smoke/video of sewer lines and sent to Ed Hargraves for his evaluations of the bids. Ed Hargraves liked the proposed Trekk, where the smoke is sent through all the lines (noting the areas) and then inspect with cameras, further stating that either company would do a great job. A motion was made by Alderman Bodkins to accept the bid by Trekk and Alderman Conder seconded the motion. The voting is as follows: Kenneth Bodkins, Aye, Larry Conder, Aye, P. B. Conley, Aye and John Reddick, Aye.

A motion was made by Alderman Bodkins to adjourn the special called meeting and it was seconded by Alderman Reddick. All aldermen voted, Aye. The meeting was adjourned.
