

REGULAR MEETING OF THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF ALDERMAN

MONDAY, FEBRUARY 3, 2020 AT CITY HALL AT 5:00 P.M.

97 SOUTH JOHNSON STREET, ALAMO, TENNESSEE

Mayor Emison called the meeting to order.

Roll was called with the following Aldermen present: Kenneth Bodkins, Larry Conder and John Reddick.

Invocation was given by Reverend Dr. Sonny Davis, with the Mississippi River District of the United Methodist Church.

Others present: Rita Reasons, Ferris Arnold and Neal Towater.

Mayor Emison gave his monthly report on the following items: 1) Ryan North will return to re-survey the old portion of the cemetery. 2) The water plant CDBG grant work has been completed. 3) The wells capacity is 850 gpm with the storage above ground around 350,000 gallons. 4) Mayor Emison pulled off some men to help get the salary surveys done by the end of January. 5) He approved \$1750.00 for maintenance of sewer plant generator and load test. He stated that John Gorman is working on a plan to get the maintenance on the others. 6) Medline was written a letter about the spray used that is undermining West Main and they stated that they would stop spraying on our side of the road. 7) The property located on West Main belonging to Dwayne Goldsmith, Randy Camp is in touch with the minor child's caretaker and the town is planning on cleaning it up. 8) The town is now accepting adopt-a-street, for anyone who wants to adopt a section of streets. 9) TOSHA inspected the town today and we will hear from them shortly; however the survey items seemed minor. 10) The code for the town has been reviewed and updated by MTAS and it is ready for final review for the last updates. Mayor Emison asked to set up a workshop on Monday, February 23, 2020 at 5:00 p.m.

Alderman Conley joined the meeting at 5:15 p.m.

Alderman Conley made a motion to adopt the minutes of the January 6, 2020 meeting and the motion was seconded by Alderman Bodkins. All Aldermen voted, Aye. The motion carried.

Mayor Emison reviewed Resolution 2019-7 the Plan of Service for the property located on Hwy 54 north and the Ordinance 2019-8 which is the annexation ordinance for the same property. After much discussion Alderman Bodkins made a motion to table the resolution and ordinance to May 2020 and the motion was seconded by Alderman Conder. All Aldermen voted, Aye. The motion was tabled.

Mayor Emison stated that the CDBG grant Resolutions 2020-1 is to apply for the grant. Resolution 2020-2 is for engineering services and 2020-3 is for administrative services. Alderman Bodkins made a motion to adopt Resolution 2020-1, Resolution 2020-2 and Resolution 2020-3 and Alderman Reddick seconded the motion. All Aldermen voted, Aye.

Alderman Bodkins stated that he wanted to purchase 12 more led lights for ball field lights for the smaller field at the park. Mayor Emison instructed Rita Reasons to get the lights ordered. Alderman Bodkins also presented estimated cost for supplies and installation for the lights. Alderman Bodkins asked the other board members to come up with ideas for E. D. Brown Park for some updates. Alderman Bodkins stated that he was going to donate a new roof to the park for the concession stand. However the dug-outs need some new facial boards installed by the city crew and the fence needs stapling and tightening.

Mayor Emison stated the water leak in front of Randy Camp office is still leaking and so is the one on South Johnson Street. Neal Towater stated that he had a leak in the fire department and the ceiling had fallen.

With no further business to come before the board Alderman Conley made a motion to adjourn and it was seconded by Alderman Conder. All Aldermen voted Aye. The meeting was adjourned.
