

**REGULAR MEETING OF THE ALAMO BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN  
(PARTICIPATION IN PERSON OR TELEPHONICALLY AT 844-474-0925. 19068431#)  
MONDAY, FEBRUARY 1, 2021 AT CITY HALL, 97 SOUTH JOHNSON STREET,  
ALAMO, TN 38001**

Mayor Emison called the meeting to order at City Hall.

Roll was called with the following Aldermen present: Kenneth Bodkins (telephonically), Larry Conder (telephonically), P.B. Conley (telephonically), and John Reddick (telephonically). Mayor Emison was in person at city hall.

Mayor Emison gave the invocation.

Others present: Rita Reasons and Randy Camp (telephonically), Ferris Arnold, Jeff Sills, David Kee, Loren Haynes (in person).

Randy Camp stated that the Governor's executive order allowed for the meeting to be held remotely.

Alderman Conley made a motion to adopt the minutes of the January 4, 2021 and the special called meeting on January 25, 2021 and Alderman Reddick seconded the motion. All Aldermen voted, Aye. The motion passed.

Mayor Emison gave his monthly report on the following: 1) TREKK delivered the final report on video and smoke testing of the portions of the sewer system on a flash drive. The Mayor has asked for additional clarification. 2) Gibson Connect has installed free WiFi at both city parks from a grant through the state. 3) We have entered into an apprenticeship program with Northwest development workforce board and TAUD for the water and wastewater licensing personnel. 4) Judge Conley has signed the court orders on 3 properties for demolition on the following properties: North Bells, Burns/West Main and South Cherry. 6) A reminder that day light savings time will be on March 14, 2021.

Loren Haynes stated that Gibson county is offering a 64-hour fireman training in Dyer, Tennessee on February 9, 2021. Loren stated that he had 3 men that wanted to attend. Alderman Bodkins made a motion to pay \$25.00 per class and mileage from the Alamo Fire Department to the fire department that is having the training, plus a \$200.00 bonus after they pass course and live fire test and purchasing and approximately \$3,100.00 to outfit each new recruits. Alderman Reddick seconded the motion. The voting is as follows: Alderman Bodkins, Aye, Alderman Conder, Aye, Alderman Conley, Aye and Alderman Reddick, Aye. The motion carried.

With no further business to come before the board Alderman Conder made a motion to adjourn and Alderman seconded the motion. All Aldermen voted, Aye.
