

SPECIAL CALLED MEETING OF THE ALAMO MAYOR AND BOARD OF ALDERMEN

THURSDAY, JUNE 29 AT 5:00 AT CITY HALL

Mayor Emison called the meeting to order.

Roll was called with the following aldermen present: John Reddick, P. B. Conley, Kenneth Bodkins and Larry Conder.

Invocation was given by Brother Chris Rigby.

Others present: Chad Tritt, Everett Tritt, Phil Park, Jim Knox, Randy Camp and Rita Reasons.

A public hearing was held at 4:45 p.m. with no citizens showing up for the budget discussion.

Mayor Emison stated that several items had been done since the regular meeting. The items Mayor Emison discussed: stated that he had applied for a mosquito grant with the state, the tires at Perry Automotive had been moved, the rate study for water was finished by TAUD, the Shirley King house on S. Mill Street had been demolished and Chief Knox was awarded a 60K generator from the military. Mayor Emison welcomed Randy Camp as the town's new attorney.

A motion was made by Alderman Bodkins to adopt the Ordinance 2017-3 establishing processing fees for debit or credit cards for utility customers, seconded by Alderman Conder. All Aldermen voted, Aye. The motion passed on the second reading.

A motion was made by Alderman Conley to adopt the Ordinance 2017-4, establishing a fee schedule for water/sewer customers, seconded by Alderman Reddick. The voting as recorded: Alderman Conder, Aye, Alderman Conley, Aye, Alderman Bodkins, Aye and Alderman Reddick, Aye. The motion passed on the second and final reading.

A motion was made by Alderman Bodkins to adopt the 2017/2018 budget, seconded by Alderman Conley. The voting is as follows: Alderman Reddick, Aye, Alderman Conley, Aye, Alderman Bodkins, Aye and Alderman Conder, Aye. The motion passed on the second and final reading.

Mayor Emison explained Ordinance 2017-5, an Ordinance to adopt the new zoning map of Alamo. A motion was made by Alderman Conder to adopt the ordinance and seconded by Alderman Bodkins. All Aldermen voted, Aye. The motion passed.

With no further business to come before the board a motion was made by Alderman Conley to adjourn, seconded by Alderman Reddick. The motion passed and the meeting was adjourned.
