

**MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE  
ALAMO MAYOR AND BOARD OF ALDERMEN  
MONDAY, MAY 2, 2022 AT 5:00 P.M. AT CITY HALL  
97 SOUTH JOHNSON STREET, ALAMO, TENNESSEE, 38001**

**Mayor Emison called the meeting to order.**

**Roll was called with the following Aldermen present: P.B. Conley, Jim Knox, Michael Moore, and John Reddick.**

**Invocation was given by Chief Jeff Sills.**

**Others present: Amanda Harris, Chief Jeff Sills, Ferris Arnold, Jim Barazza, Loren Haynes, and Judge Conley.**

**A motion was made by Alderman Conley to accept the minutes of the April 4, 2022 meeting and Alderman Knox seconded the motion. All Aldermen present voted, Aye.**

**Mayor's notes consisted of Tomorrow May 3, 2022 is election day. Advise the board that the school loan closing is set for May 5<sup>th</sup> at 10am. TDOT inspection of the bridge on Sunnyhill Road was good. Playground equipment will be here July 19, 2022. Martin Paving came back and took care of all problem areas. It's the time of the year to put together the next FY's paving package. Streets and Police Department should make a list of any problem areas for our Paving Package this summer. The port a potty's will be delivered, to our parks, prior to Memorial Day weekend. We will have those from Memorial Day to around Labor Day. Façade Grant Letter is being drafted. Frank Moore started part-time. Frank Moore would prefer to do mowing around the city on a contract basis. The company that is starting the cured in place piping job have started their work around town. Junk pick-up was completed. We have a sewer drain issue on W Church ST. and the engineers advise to camera the lines before digging or changing anything. We have not bid out the cemetery mowing for five years so we will be doing that for this season. Alamo Fire Dept has an extra truck to donate to Street Dept. Junior Gorman's retirement party will be Monday May 23, 2022 at noon. We still have an opening on the Police Dept. and only one applicant applied for the job. Applicant resides outside of the county. Asking the board to waive the 5-mile discretion. Alderman Jim Knox voted to waive the motion. Alderman Reddick seconded the motion. All other alderman voted Aye.**

**In New Business, Judge Conley gave an update on CMC. The committee investigated where the Negro Cemetery potentially was. The committee has decided to put a monument up to memorialize these unknown graves. They are trying to find the grant money to fund it otherwise it's in the budget for this upcoming FY. Alderman Reddick made a motion to accept the committee's recommendation. Alderman Knox seconded the motion. All other Alderman voted Aye.**

**Junior Gorman proposed a salary to work part-time until we have a certified operator. Motion was made by Alderman Moore to accept the proposal. Alderman Conley seconded the motion. All other Alderman voted Aye.**

**Special Called Meeting will be Monday May 9, 2022 to discuss budget and Presentation of the Audit by ATA.**

**The Mayor and Alderman did an overview of FY 2023 Budget.**

**Old Business, Alderman Reddick said water is standing on West Church and asking what can be done. A2H will look into this next time they are in town. Alderman Conley asking to check culverts. Alderman Reddick said Burns Street manhole lids are being blown off after heavy rain. We will keep an eye on that.**

**Alderman Conley made the motion to adjourn, Alderman Knox seconded the motion. All voted Aye. Meeting is adjourned.**
