

REGULAR MEETING OF THE ALAMO MAYOR AND BOARD OF ALDERMEN

MONDAY, OCTOBER 1, 2018 AT 5:00 P.M. AT CITY HALL

Mayor Emison called the meeting to order.

Roll was called with the following Aldermen present: John Reddick, P.B. Conley, and Larry Conder.

Invocation was given by Reverend James Levene, Lighthouse United Methodist Church

Others present: Amanda Harris, Randy Camp, Jim Knox, Tommy Allen, Neal Towater, Ferris Arnold

Mayor Emison gave his monthly report for the following items: The painting of City Hall will begin Tuesday October 2, 2018. Town Auction will be held on October 27, 2018. Mayor stated we received an estimate of \$96,000 from Ed Hargraves office of the cost to put the grit removal system back in operation at the sewer plant. TDEC has not yet demanded this. The new sewer station for Medline is up and running but not completed yet. Mayor Emison gave an update on the work progress around the Courtsquare. Gibson Electric has agreed to pay half the cost to move and replace the metal pole. Elaine Avery and Robert Thomas have agreed to share a 25% cost of the work that will be done in front of their buildings. This will help offset some of the costs of the work being done.

Alderman Bodkins joined the meeting.

Kenneth Bodkins made a motion to adopt the minutes from the September Board Meeting. PB Conley seconded the motion. The motion was carried.

Tommy Allen, Chairman of the Downtown Committee spoke on the progress and upcoming meetings of the committee. Stated this was a three-year long process.

Second reading on Ordinance 2018-10 Copier Lease Ordinance. PB Conley made the motion to adopt. Larry Conder second the motion. The motion carried.

Second reading on Ordinance 2018-11 Cemetery Ordinance. PB Conley made the motion to adopt. Kenneth Bodkins second the motion. The motion carried.

First Reading by Mayor Emison on Ordinance 2018-12 Adult Oriented Businesses. After some discussion Alderman Bodkins made a motion to accept this Ordinance subject to Attorney Randy Camp looking over it. Alderman Conder second the motion. All Alderman were in favor and the motion carried.

First reading by Mayor Emison on Ordinance 2018-13 Outside City Limits Fire Calls. This Ordinance gives the Fire Chief the ability to make a judgement call on the billing process of a

fire call. Alderman Conder made the motion to adopt this Ordinance. Alderman Conley seconded this motion. The motion carried.

After a discussion the Adopting Employee Handbook was tabled until after the Special Call Meeting that will take place October 8, 2018 at 5:30 PM.

With no further business before the Board Alderman Bodkins made a motion to adjourn, seconded by Alderman Reddick. Motion carried.
