

**MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE  
ALAMO MAYOR AND BOARD OF ALDERMEN  
MONDAY, OCTOBER 6, 2025 AT 5:00 P.M. AT CITY HALL  
97 SOUTH JOHNSON STREET, ALAMO, TENNESSEE, 38001**

Mayor Bodkins called the meeting to order.

Roll was called with the following Aldermen present: P.B. Conley, John Reddick, Laura Bell and Jim Knox.

Invocation was given by Mayor Kenneth Bodkins.

Others present: Amanda Griffin, Jeff Sills, and Loren Haynes.

A motion was made by Aldermen Conley to accept the minutes of the September 7, 2025, Regular meeting. Aldermen Reddick seconded the motion. All Aldermen present voted, Aye. The minutes were approved.

Mayor's Notes included: Loren Haynes, Alamo Fire Chief, is present to provide an update. Chief Haynes stated two (2) weeks ago Jesse Stroud was elected for Lieutenant and Nick Vestal is Captain. Lt. Stroud helping with the maintenance, among other things including record keeping. Captain Vestal helping with training. Captain Vestal just completed part of his instructor training. The online training platform is completed and in use at this time. Captain Vestal has been assigning online classes. Once Mr. Casey confirms classes then we will recruit people. An updated firefighter roster will be provided to Recorder Griffin due to worker's comp purposes. Chief Jeff Sills with Alamo Police Dept. provided everyone with a copy of his monthly report. Mayor Bodkins stated, there are issues with the new installed meters with USG that need to be addressed. If issues do not get resolved may have to cancel contract with them. Amanda Griffin and I met with USA Water Solutions whom provided us with 12 free pilot meters to install and try. Once Ferris gets back next week, we will work on getting those pilot meters installed and turn them on. Those pilot meters work off cellphone towers. Mrs. Griffin stated that Mr. Tracy with USG says that they do not integrate until after the whole town is installed. The town cannot commit to it if cannot see the full package of how it works. The city owns the pilot meters. The recent pilot meters provided by USA Water Solutions, they do not know if they will work with our system at this time. Mayor Bodkins stated backhoe is down again and waiting on cylinder to come in. Dump truck is down and waiting for a cylinder. The generator behind the Health Department that is inspected yearly was struck by lightning which a claim was turned in to Public Entity Partners. Mayor Bodkins stated at any time anyone is welcome to put anything on the agenda as long you as notify Mrs. Griffin.

**In new business, Resolution 2025-11: A Resolution to authorize application for the Supplemental Disaster Recovery Funding Program. Alderman Knox made a motion to approve. Alderman Reddick seconded the motion. Roll was called. All present voted, Aye. Motion was approved.**

**Resolution 2025-12 A Resolution for the Use of City Owned Vehicles. After discussion, this resolution will be discussed further at next meeting. Aldermen Knox made a motion to approve. Aldermen Reddick seconded the motion. Roll was called. All Aldermen present voted, Aye.**

**Resolution 2025-13 A Resolution to apply for Federal Assistance. After discussion, Aldermen Bell made a motion to approve. Aldermen Conley seconded the motion. Roll was called. All present voted, Aye.**

**First reading of Ordinance 2025-9 an Ordinance to amend the Official Code of the Town of Alamo Adopting the 2018 Edition of the International Residential Code. Aldermen Bell made a motion to approve the ordinance on first reading. Aldermen Knox seconded the motion. Roll was called. All Aldermen present voted, Aye.**

**First reading of Ordinance 2025-10 An Ordinance to amend the Official Code of the Town of alamo Adopting the 2018 Edition of the International Energy Conservation Code. Aldermen Kox made a motion to approve the ordinance on first reading. Aldermen Conley seconded the motion. Roll was called. All Aldermen present voted, Aye.**

**First reading of the Ordinance 2025-11 An Ordinance to Rename the Alamo Municipal Building to the Thomas "Tommy" Green Municipal Building. After discussion, Aldermen Knox made a motion to approve the ordinance on first reading. Aldermen Reddick seconded the motion. Roll was called. All Aldermen present voted, Aye.**
